FEDERATION BY – LAWS

Article 1. Name, headquarters and activity

- 1) The Federation bears the name “World Sports karate Extent i.e. called as World Sports Karate Federation” and is the union of all clubs and organizations across the world devoted to all Martial arts style. This will be non-profit orientated and it should not be the commercial business.
- 2) The Federation has its headquarters in Tamilnadu (Coimbatore) – India, and President Office in Utterpradesh – India and its legal controlled by Non-Olympic Committee
- 3) The Federation’s official languages are English.

Article 2. Purpose

- 1) The World Sports Karate Federation is the International umbrella organization of all National Sports Karate Federation –Martial Arts Games-Players. The WSKE is an International Non-Governmental, Non-Profit organization of unlimited duration.
- 2) The promotion of the all Martial Arts & karate
- 3) The support of the Non-Olympic activities and representation of the Non-Olympic games international level.

Article 3. Activities aimed at realizing the Federation’s purpose

- 1) The purpose of the Federation shall be achieved by the following activities:
 - a) Group training and social get-togethers.
 - b) Organize the seminars and tournaments.
- 2) The necessary financial and material means shall be raised by:
 - a) Membership fees (currency in US \$)
 - b) Profits from events
 - c) Donations and other allocations.

Article 4. Types of membership

- 1) WSKE follows one type of membership i.e. National Membership
- 2) National members are the members who participate fully in the Federation’s work and only one member is permitted per country.
- 3) National members are natural and legal persons who support the Non-Olympic activities of the Federation

Chapter 4a Fees of WSKE

- 1) The country has paid every year: 25 US\$ to the account of the World Sports Karate Federation.
- 3) Those Money must paid to 2nd weeks of January of the year
- 4) WSKE receives the money through Donation. Through this Donation the WSKE organize the seminars, Tournaments and Meeting.
- 5) International registration of the Dan grade costs will be collected.
- 6) For Money Transaction we use Separate Bank account in the Name of Federation: Details Are

Article 5. Acquiring of membership

- 1) The President, Vice-President and General Secretary make the final decision regarding appointment of National Directors.

Article 6. Cancellation of membership

- 1) Membership is Cancelled because of death (in the case of this student can take part).
- 2) Resignation is accepted only at the end of each year.
- 3) The President, Vice-President and General Secretary may cancel a membership without paying membership fees.
- 4) National activities against Non-Olympic the membership will be cancelled.

Article 7. Members Rights

- 1) Members have rights to participate in Non-Olympic Games other members will not be allowed.

Article 9. The General Meeting

- 1) The regular General Meeting takes places yearly once.
- 2) The members fails to participate in the meeting the postings will be cancelled.
- 3) All members shall be invited, in writing, for the General Meetings at least two years once members should be participated General Meeting.

4) If National Members fails to participate the Meeting the particular nation will not take part into the Non-Olympic Game.

5) Third Party will not allowed to Meeting

Article 10. Tasks of the General Meeting

The following details are submitted in front of all members:

1) Announcing the Annual Report and the Annual Financial Report.

2) Passing Sports Karate Non-Olympic Game budget estimates.

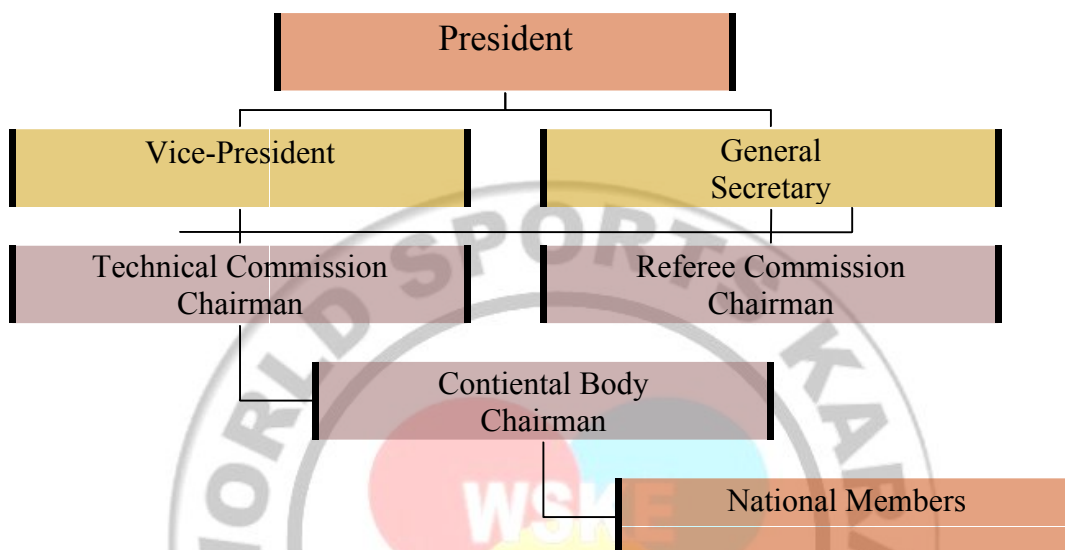
3) Appointing and dismissing members of the Board & the Auditors.

7) Passing new edition rules and regulation of the Federation.

Article 11. The Board

- 1) The Board consists of five members: the President, Vice-President, General Secretary/Treasurer, Regional Chairman, technical Commission Chairman, Referee Commission and National Director.



Article 12. Responsibilities of Board members

- 1) The President occupies the Federation's highest leadership position. He is responsible for the representation of the Federation. He is the chairperson of General Meeting and the Board.– while taking full responsibility for them – on all matters that fall within the Board's area of activity.

2) Vice-President & General Secretary shall support the President in managing the Federation's Sports activities. He is responsible for keeping the all of the General Meeting and Board meetings. And General Secretary act as Treasurer is responsible for conducting the Federation's financial affairs in an proper manner.

4) The Federation's written documents and announcements, especially documents binding for the Federation, are to be signed jointly by the President, Vice-President & General Secretary.

5) If the President is unable to fulfill his duties, the Vice-President & General Secretary will fulfill all duties.

Article 14. The Auditors

1) The General Meeting elects the auditors for a period of five years. Re-election is permitted.

2) The Auditors are responsible for the regular inspection of all activities and auditing the Annual Financial Report. The Auditors are to be report on the results of the audit at the General Meeting other wise the Auditor will be changed.

Article 15. The Legal Commission

1) The Legal Commission is responsible for all Legal activities and Should Face all Legal problems.

Article 16. Legal Action

1) The Judicial should be in India not in other country. If any body take legal action against this organization the court should be in India not in other Country.
