All students will study both practical training classes at the branches of WSKE over the world and via online learning for conceptual and theoretical subjects. These programs therefore are not pure online distance learning mode but part-time practical training study with online learning nature.

Diploma in Martial Arts Management

Objectives of the course

- To produce well-trained Exercise and Martial Arts knowledge.
- To spread the message of positive health as taught in Martial Arts importance & exercise to the people in a systematic and scientific manner.
- To provide a proper perspective and insight into various aspects of exercise, fitness and knowledge of Martial Arts.

Admission Requirements

Applicants for admission to the Diploma in Martial Arts Management Structure (D.M.A) should have passed the minimum level of any martial arts from any organization or accepted by the syndicate as equivalent.

Duration of the course

The course is for a period of one academic year

Course Structure & Distribution of Teaching Hours

The course of study shall comprise theoretical instructions, supervised practical training in Martial Arts exercises and practice teaching as well as systematic maintenance of lesson plans. There shall be Four papers in all. There shall be a total number of practical training 48 actual contact hours (i.e. Monthly 2 day training, each day two hours practical training) in one year. Each theory paper shall have online training. There shall be Four theory and One practical paper. (Note: For Practical training, attendance is compulsory)

Post Graduate Diploma in Martial Arts Management

Admission Requirements

Applicants for admission to the Post Graduate Diploma in Martial Arts Management Structure (P.G.D.M.A) should have passed the minimum level of any martial arts from any organization or accepted by the syndicate as equivalent. Also, applicants should have teaching experience in martial arts field.

Duration of the course

The course is for a period of one academic year

Course Structure & Distribution of Teaching Hours

The course of study shall comprise theoretical instructions, supervised practical training in Martial Arts exercises and practice teaching as well as systematic maintenance of lesson plans. There shall be Six papers in all. There shall be a total number of practical training 48 actual contact hours (i.e. Monthly 2 day training, each day two hours practical training) in one year. Each theory paper shall have online training. There shall be Six theory and One practical paper. (Note: For Practical training, attendance is compulsory)

Bachelor of Arts in Martial Arts Management

This is a well-structured bachelor degree program at university level suitable for those who are interested in studying martial arts as an academic qualification.

Objectives of the course

- To produce well-trained Exercise and Martial Arts knowledge.
- To spread the message of positive health as taught in Martial Arts importance & exercise to the people in a systematic and scientific manner.
- To provide a proper perspective and insight into various aspects of exercise, fitness and knowledge of Martial Arts.

- To provide proper management and leadership skills and concepts for martial artists in managing their schools, students and daily lives.
- To equip students to be martial artists as their future working career.

Admission Requirements

Applicants for admission to the Bachelor of Arts in Martial Arts Management Structure (B.A.M.A) should have passed the minimum level of any martial arts from any organization or accepted by the syndicate as equivalent. Also, applicants should consider martial arts as their future career.

Duration of the course

The course should be completed in four academic years but students of WSKE or equivalent as accepted by the syndicate will grant full exemptions from the foundation course of first academic year so this degree can be completed in three academic years.

Course Structure & Distribution of Teaching Hours

The course of study shall comprise theoretical instructions, supervised practical training in Martial Arts exercises and practice teaching as well as systematic maintenance of lesson plans. There shall be Nine papers in all. There shall be a total number of practical training 145 actual contact hours (i.e. Monthly 2 day training, each day two hours practical training) in one year. Each theory paper shall have online training. There shall be Nine theory, One graduation project and One practical paper. The practical examination shall consist of Teaching, Demonstration and Viva-voce examination.(Note: For Practical training, attendance is compulsory)

Course Subjects (Total Credits: 120. 30 credits exempted and 90 credits to be earned.)

Year 1 (Foundation Subjects)

Students of WSKE or equivalent as accepted by the syndicate will grant exemptions from all above subjects of foundation course year.
